

Polymer Clay Coasters

Supplies needed:

- Clay in your favorite colors *I use 5 packs for a set of coasters
 - Round cookie cutter
 - Rolling pin
 - Parchment paper + a baking sheet
 - Cutting board
 - Wipes for your hands
- *optional: clear nail polish to varnish, gold acrylic paint for the outside edges for some shine

Steps:

1. Roll your clay into several “snake” like shapes
2. Twist colors together
3. Flatten with your rolling pin, until you get your desired marbled effect
4. Use a cookie cutter, press into clay + then remove excess clay
5. Place on parchment paper + place on baking sheet

How to Bake Your Clay: You can bake your polymer clay items on a tray covered with Aluminum Foil or Parchment Paper, either in the toaster oven or the regular oven.

Temperature & Time: Use the Bake setting at 275 degrees and bake for approximately 20-25 minutes. You can flip it to the other side after 10 minutes if you'd like.

After Baking: Let cool for 24 hours before touching, or before placing any items on top of your coasters.

***Optional:** clear nail polish to varnish, gold acrylic paint for the outside edges for some shine.
