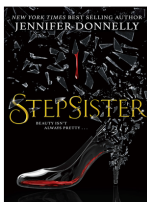


Recommended Fairytale Titles



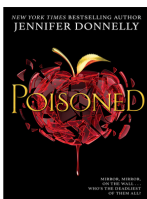
Stepsister *by Jennifer Donnelly* **YA FIC DONNELLY**

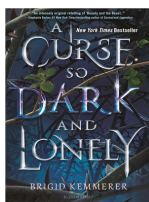
Echo North *by Joanna Ruth Meyer* **YA FIC MEYER**

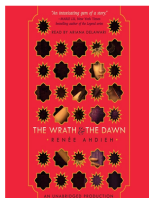


A Curse so Dark and Lonely

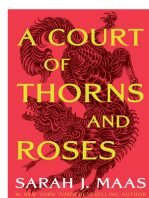


A Blade so Black

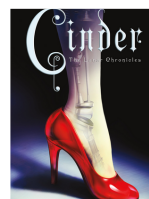


A Court of Thorns and Roses

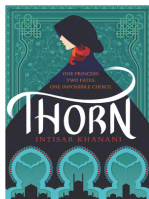
Girl, Serpent, Thorn
