So, he sets out to find the ghost of his murdered cousin and set it free. He's determined to find out what happened and tie up some loose ends before he leaves. Yadriel agrees to help Julian, so that they can both get what they want. But the longer Yadriel spends with Julian, the less he wants to let him leave.


The Bone Houses by Emily Lloyd-Jones YA FIC LLOYD-JONES


