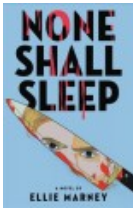


# Recommended **Mystery** Titles

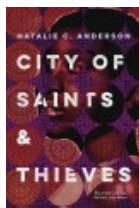
**Little Monsters** *by Kara Thomas*

**YA FIC STOKES**

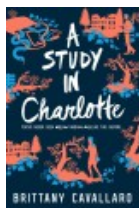

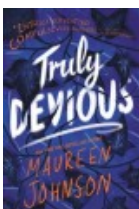

## I Killed Zoe Spanos *by Kit Frick*

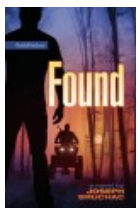

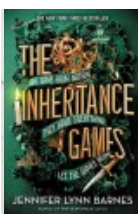
**Monday's Not Coming** *by Tiffany D. Jackson*

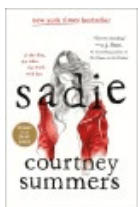
**Found** *by Joseph Bruchac*

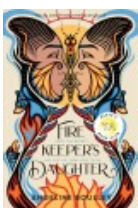
**The Inheritance Games** *by Jennifer Lynn Barnes*
