

CARDS FOR VETERANS

Earn an hour of community service for every 5 cards you make for veterans under the care of Good Shepherd Hospice in Port Jefferson.

Rules:

- All work submitted must be neat, and follow guidelines.
- When writing or drawing, make sure the colors are dark enough for the veterans to be able to read.
- Any cards submitted that do not follow the guidelines will not count towards community service.
- **Limit of 2 submissions per month, for a total of 10 cards.**

Supplies Needed:

- Plain paper or cardstock folded into quarters
- Colored pencils, crayons or markers.

Steps to Take:

- Fold your paper into quarters
- Create a colorful, patriotic image or saying in nice lettering on the front. Make sure it is legible and in dark/bold colors.

Some examples include:

- American Flag
- Statue of Liberty
- Bald Eagle
- On the inside write a few nice words, or heartfelt message.

Some examples include:

- Thank you for your service.
- God bless America.
- Wish them a happy holiday
 - Veteran's Day
 - Memorial Day
 - Fourth of July
- Make sure you have met all criteria, drop off the cards at the Adult Reference Desk and fill out your community service form provided at the desk.
